## Limiting Content Sources to Specific Folders and Drives

In some cases, you may want to assign only a folder or drive as a content source. To create a content source that is only a folder or drive:

- 1. Click the Content Management tab
- 2. Select the content repository where the drive or folder is located
- 3. Navigate to and select the drive or folder
- 4. Click the right corner menu in the Activity Bar (3 dots)
- 5. Select Clone with Root Path
